RIALTO RECEIVES \$10,000 CHECK FROM MEDLINE INDUSTRIES

On Saturday, June 4, 2022, Rialto Community Services Department received a \$10,000 check from Medline. During opening ceremonies for Rialto's co-ed basketball league, Medline's Public Affairs Director Jesse Greenberg and Operations Director Don Sutphin presented a check to Cynthia Alvarado-Crawford, Director of Community Services.

"The money will be deposited into a scholarship fund to be used for those youth who cannot afford to pay program or sports registration fees in Rialto," said Cynthia. "Medline and the city are going to do great things together. The biggest thing is bridging the gap between the cost for activities and economic inequality."

Half of the twenty-four basketball teams showed up at the Carl Johnson Gymnasium for opening ceremonies. Families packed the bleachers; the sidelines too. The eager crowd was amazed by the partnership between Medline Industries and Rialto Community Services and excited to hear how it would affect the kids in the city.

"We're getting more than a donation from Medline," Cynthia said. "We're getting a partnership that benefits the kids and families in Rialto. On top of the donation, Medline has inquired about volunteering to help us with our sports programs."

“It’s important for families to be able to have their children participate in sports because of the health benefits and life lessons that come with it,” said Medline’s Jesse Greenberg. “Medline is a part of the Rialto community, and we feel committed to help our neighbors who need a little support.”

Currently, Rialto runs multiple sports programs: basketball, volleyball, and Tiny Tot sports. The Community Services Department also offers Kung Fu and Folklorico classes, which will be considered for scholarships.
